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Teachers Guide to Aeronautical Activities Activity No. 6

Enter A Competition

This task can take considerable time and in many cases will give the opportunity for children to work in groups. These competitions are generally aimed at teenagers and some will involve substantial commitment hence can be used as a 'club' activity. The competitions are a great way to engage teenagers and expose them to career in aeronautics. There are also competitions on the Fly Higher web site which include drawings and story writing competitions that younger children can attempt.

Time Required: This varies tremendously depending on the competition to be entered. There is such a wide variety available. Although some of the competition tasks would fit into a single lesson, most are probably best treated as extra-curriculum or 'off-timetable' exercises.

Resources Required: Depending on the competitions, there can be considerable resources as well as time required. It will be necessary to pick the competition carefully. They can be

used as a source of ideas and projects that a teacher can select to create active exercises.
