To schools:

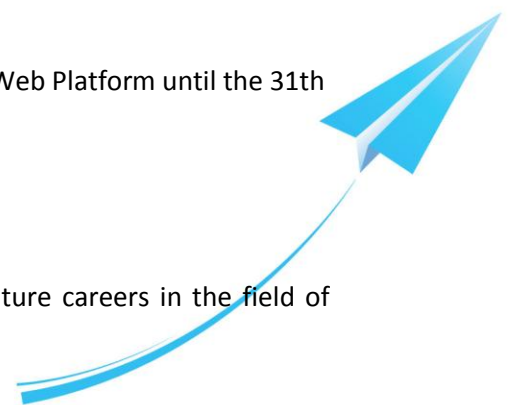
- FLY HIGHER participant certificate for the schools with at least 25 students in the competition.
